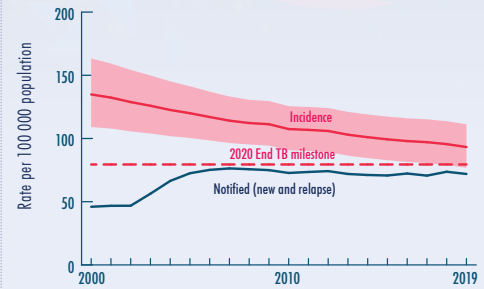

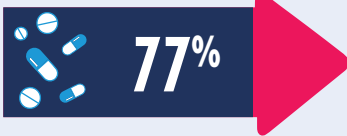


TB INCIDENCE 2000-2019



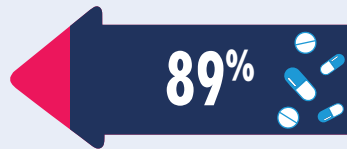

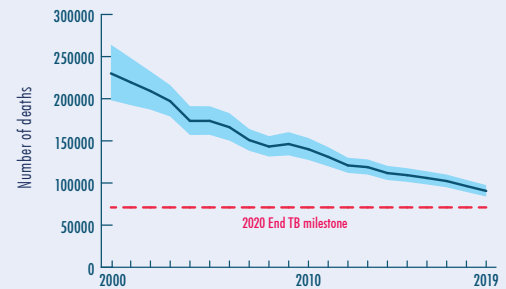

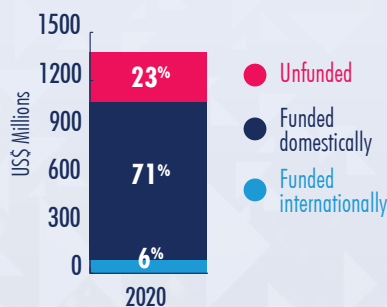
